

PUBLIC NOTICE

For registration of unregistered Child Care Institution under JJ Act 2015

All unregistered Child Care Institution(CCI) running in the name of Ashram / Kendra / Griha / Niketan / Madrasa etc. accommodating Children in the age group of 0-18 years, providing boarding, lodging facilities, service of Institutional Care for Children, providing support to Children of poor economic background, providing Shelter support to orphan under RMSA, SSA, CBSE, CISE, Madrasa Board etc.

As per section 41 of the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection) of Children Act 2015, it is compulsory to get them registered under the Juvenile Justice System.

Any new NGO, Voluntary organization, charity organization, religious organization, socio economic organization or civil society organization or any organization run by the State Government or by the Central Government , which are meant , either wholly or partially , for housing children in Need of Care & Protection as defined under section 2 , clause (n) or children in conflict with law and which are not registered either under any of the state Govt. or Govt. of India recognized , education board or any other law for the time being in force shall be registered under the relevant section of the JJ Act 2015. Whoever contravene this section shall be subject to the following, as per section 42 of the JJ Act 2015

1. Shall be punished with Imprisonment, which may extend to 1 year or fine not less than 1 lakh or both
2. Every 30-day delay in applying for registration shall be considered as separate crime

With this regard an advertisement is issued dated 26/07/2017 by State Child Protection Society, Social Welfare Department, Govt of Assam.Hence all office bearer of the Organization dealing with Children and having facilities for boarding / lodging as mentioned above are hereby instructed to do the needful to apply for registration or renewal of registration, If any clarification needed, all are requested to contact the respective District Child Protection Officers Office in the concerned District. Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of WP(C) no. 470/2005, Sampurna Behrua on dated 25/08/2017 clearly instructed all the unregistered CCIs to complete the registration process & State Government is viewing the matter as most urgent. DCPO of concerned district as head of the DCPU, Superintendent of Police as head of the District Law & Order are together mandate to take the above mention action against the violator immediately with effect from 1st January 2018 .Ignorance of Law will not be entertain as an excuse.
